Thank you for your interest in attending 4-H Volunteer Leaders Training. I invite you to complete our "Volunteer Application for Scholarship." As you may know, the state 4-H office has required volunteer leaders to participate in at least two training per year in order to maintain their club charter. The purpose of this form is to ensure that the greatest number of people have the opportunity to participate in our most beneficial training, and that allocations are determined in an equitable and timely manner.

Please observe the following in completing this form:

- Section I of the form is to be completed and returned to the Granville County 4-H office at least two weeks prior to the registration deadline. Requests after that time may be considered for reimbursement, but you will be responsible for up-front financial arrangements,
- Section III of the form is to be completed during and following the conference. Section III should be returned to the Granville County 4-H office within 30 day following the conclusion of the conference.
- Any paperwork related to conference attendance, such as receipts or confirmation of registration, must be submitted to the Granville County 4-H office within 30 days following the conclusion of the conference.
- Funding decisions in response to the Volunteer Application for Scholarship will be based in part on the availability of funds. Additional considerations will include your level of involvement with local 4-H programs, the number of trainings that you have attended and for which you have received financial support, and leadership roles in which you serve at the county and district levels.

Training is offered at the district, state, and regional levels. Additionally, I will offer training at the local level. However, training need not come from one sole entity as we can learn a great deal from one another as staff, volunteers, youth, and community members. As such, ***any volunteer who participates in training with the support of Granville County 4-H will be required to prepare and present a local training for staff, volunteers, youth, and community members are appropriate.***
