#### PLEASE READ THE FOLLOWING INFORMATION BEFORE YOU REGISTER!

- Please verify that we have an updated email address for your child. <u>Camp enrollment</u> <u>confirmation/waitlist will be sent by email within 48 hours of registration.</u> Updates, changes and instructions for specific camps may also be sent by email.
- Cancellations or changes to any camps must be made by email (<u>gwen\_hernandez@ncsu.edu</u>). No request will be taken by phone. Phone calls should only be made for emergency or last minute situations.
- Camp spots cannot be reserved without payment.
- Scholarship forms are available at the front desk and on the website.
- Be sure to check age requirements and locations as you review activities in which to enroll your child.
- Waiting lists will be available after camps fill up.
- **Due to confidentiality**, we are unable to provide you with the names of other youth signed up for camps. Please do not request to see the sign-up sheets.
- Fees cover insurance and supplies.
- Camp fees are **not refundable**.
- Registration is first come, first serve. Payment is required at the time of registration. Cash and checks only. <u>Checks should be made payable to Granville County 4-H. You must bring the correct change if</u> you are paying with cash.
- You may register in person or by mail. If you choose to mail in your registration, you MUST have completed the following:
  - Summer Fun Registration Form
  - 4-H Enrollment Form (as of January 2017)
  - Medical Release Form-this must be notarized, which can be done at our office (please call the office ahead of time to insure someone is available to notarize your form). You cannot sign the form before it is notarized, it must be signed in the presence of a notary.
- If paying with Clover Cash, you must <u>submit</u> the clover cash with the registration form. The office will not have a record of the clover cash.
- Granville County 4-H follows the 4-H Code of Conduct. Please review this with your child before they attend. These forms are located at the front desk in the office and on our website.

\*The start and end times for these events are to be strictly enforced. Please do not drop off your child more than 15 minutes prior to the camp starting and pick them up no more than 15 minutes past the end time.

\*If you need to make payments on a camp, please let Gwen know at time of registration. Payments will be due in full 1 week before camp occurs. If payment is not collected, your child's spot will be filled with someone on the waiting list. If you would like to apply for a 4-H camp scholarship, please ask Gwen for a form at registration. These are limited and go to those in highest need. \_\_\_\_\_ Initial

\*Due to NC law, 4-H staff is not allowed to apply or supply sunscreen or insect repellent to your child. If the camp is taking place outside, please be sure to supply your child sunscreen/insect repellent and teach him/her to properly apply it. \_\_\_\_\_ Initial

\*Also, due to NC law, 4-H staff cannot supply or install car seats. If a car seat is needed, please provide one and place in the 4-H van. Your child's safety is very important to us! \_\_\_\_\_\_ Initial
