meets on the first Tuesday of each month in Oxford

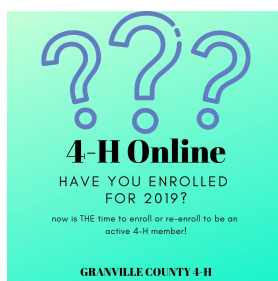
4-H Rockers of Creedmoor Club meets on the second Tuesday of each month in Creedmoor
