The primary purpose of this scholarship is to assist students, both youth and adults, in obtaining a college education in a 4-year degree preferably, but not exclusively, in life sciences, agriculture or family and consumer science or a 2-year degree in most any service or business-related field. Students, youth or adults, must be enrolled at an accredited school in North Carolina.

Applicants will be selected for a one-year term, primarily on the basis of academia, activities and honors. Financial need is considered. A grade point average of 2.5 must be maintained to receive the second payment.

All things equal, priority will be given to relatives of EVA members.
